END OF SUMMER - RECIPE



Smore's Casserole

(L) 12 - 15 minutes

INGREDIENTS

Graham crackers or digestive biscuits (about 16 full sheets or their crushed crumbs)

- **7oz.** Milk chocolate bars or semisweet chocolate chips
- · 3 Cups Mini marshmallows
- Butter (for greasing dish or mixing with graham cracker crumbs)

DIRECTIONS

Step 1: Preheat oven to 350–390°F (175–200°C). Butter or grease a 9x9 or 8x8 inch baking dish.

Break half the graham crackers into smaller pieces and spread them evenly on the bottom of the dish.

Scatter or layer chocolate pieces on top

Step 2: scatter or layer chocolate pieces on top. Spread half the marshmallows evenly over chocolate. Add the remaining graham crackers as a second layer, then top with the rest of the marshmallows.

Step 3: Bake 12–15 minutes until marshmallows are golden brown and chocolate melted. If marshmallows brown too quickly, cover loosely with foil and bake longer. Let cool slightly before serving.
