#### Brie, Fig, and Apple **Grilled Cheese**

1 tablespoon olive oil 1/4 red onion, sliced 2 tablespoon soft butter, for brushing the bread or jam

thinly sliced

1 large Granny Smith apple, thinly sliced 1/2 cup baby arugula

Heat the olive oil in a small skillet. Add the onion slices and cook until caramelized, stirring occasionally, about 5 minutes. Set aside.
