

On your smartphone, open a photo and tap "Edit." Play with the "Light" (to sliders for brighten a dark photo), "Color" (to make colors richer), and "Straighten" (to fix a crooked horizon). A small adjustment can make a big difference.

The most powerful tip is to "Crop." Removing distracting elements from the edges of your photo instantly makes main subject the star.


